Fugro EMU has delivered regulatory approvals for exploration, development and decommissioning projects in regulatory regimes around the world.


Oil Spill Contingency Planning

Oil pollution emergency plans (OPEPs), oil spill contingency plans (OSCPs) and oil spill response plans (OSRPs) are legal requirements for many regulatory regimes, preparing operators and authorities who deal with all categories of accidental hydrocarbon spills.
